

Backup Process Overview

1. Make a exact digital copy of the physical disc using [Makemkv](#).
2. Open your new .MKV file using [Subtitle Edit](#) to look for default \ forced tracks and make note.
3. Compress your .MKV file using [Handbrake](#). (Select correct Audio tracks and format as well as subtitles).
4. Test your new file to make sure play back looks good using VLC or similar player.
5. Normalize your compressed .MKV file name and copy to final storage location.
(Recommend using [Filebot](#))
6. Clean up\Remove original uncompressed MKV copy.
7. Archive \ Access your digital copies using an application like Plex or Jellyfin.

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
